TEXT: Romans 10:1-5

SERMON TOPIC: Lord, please save my families!

Write this down: A sign of Spiritual maturity is a Burden for Souls. People who are passionate for the lost pray differently than most people. We are motivated by the prospects of salvation. We are always reaching! I Corinthians 9:22, Romans 11:14, Romans 9:1-5

Write this down: Too many people today are satisfied with their version of a relationship with God. However, there is a greater question to be asked: is God satisfied? There is more to pleasing God than acknowledging His existence. Much more! II Timothy 3:1-7

Write this down: The Lord desires to save whole households! We must live like salvation matters. We must live like we want Jesus Christ to use "us" to win "them". Acts 10:1-2, 22-24, 31, 37-40, 44

Write this down: Memo from Heaven: Effective Immediately: See "family" as souls! (Spiritual beings that belong to God.) Precious...Living Souls! (Not children, relatives, teammates, classmates, co-workers...) Ezekiel 18:4-9

Write this down: If we are to participate in the salvation of our "families" we must first convince them of our salvation, and then of the real benefits of Christ in their lives. We must live like we mean it! Hebrews 10:21-23
